RANJITSINH Gadgil, Maharaja of erstwhile Baroda state, died of cancer in a private hospital here in early hours of Thursday. He was 74.

THE JOURNEY
Born in 1938, Ranjitsinh was the second son of Maharaja Pragnanrao. After the death of his elder brother Prabhakar, he succeeded the throne in 1993. He was also an MP in 1991 and 1994 from the Mahatma constituency in Congress ranks.
